Program:

Day 1: Departure

Day 2: Arrival at the international airport in Mombasa at about 3:10 am (Turkish Airline). There you are picked up and you go directly to the Hotel Sonrisa on the south coast. After refreshing, you can enjoy a good breakfast and then relax at the beach. Against 15:30 pm the group meets for a first acquaintance and a meeting, also on the main subjects for photography with Andreas. In the evening, under the guidance of Andreas Levi, the first sunset will be "professionally" recorded over the African bush. Who is not tired then, can also scan the unforgettable starry sky yet.

Day 3: For the early risers a fantastic sunrise over the Indian Ocean is today, in clear weather, on the program. After breakfast we go on a photo walk through the Kaya Kinondo Forest. Kaya Kinondo Sacred Forest is one of the oldest original sacred forests on the Kenyan coast. Covering an area of 30 hectares and 187 plant species, 48 bird species and 45 different butterflies and it protects colobus monkeys and other animals. Just in time for lunch, you are back at the hotel. Later in the afternoon a walk on the beach is on the agenda.

These walks are adapted according to the tidal current on site, means: maybe morning beach walk and afternoon Kaya Kinondo Forest - hike.

Day 4: Picked up at around 6:00 am at your hotel and it goes to Tsavo East. This park is famous for its red elephants. Your first game drive begins immediately after the entry. You directly experience the fascination of Africa with the expansive views of the magnificent scenery and stunning wildlife. Around noon you reach the Ndololo Camp, where you eat lunch after checking in. After consultation with the group you start in the afternoon to another exciting game drive until evening. As a special happiness it is true if you spot the very rare wild dogs here. Dinner and overnight at the camp.

Animals in Tsavo East: Elephant, Cheetah, Lion, Leopard, Giraffe, Buffalo, Crocodile, Waterbuck, Ostrich, Kudu, Giraffe-Gazelle, Thomson's Gazelle, Impala, Grant's Gazelle, Kongoni, Wild-Dog, Zebra, Warthog and more ... over 400 species of birds

Day 5: Early in the morning it goes from 06.30 bis 08.30 am on a game drive. After a good breakfast the next game drive waits until noon. How often and how long should the game drives, you decide in the group and the weather and the light. After lunch and a short break, you meet up with Andreas to discuss the afternoon game drive. The beginning of the game drive after the wishes of the group. Another option is to take an early breakfast, packed lunch for the day and make a game drive until late afternoon - here you can visit the "Mudanda Rocks" and the "Lugard Falls". Both are further away from the camp, but with a long game drive, it is possible to reach them. At these locations, it is allowed to get out of the car and perhaps long-term exposures may be made to the waterfall here. All this you need to discuss with your group members and the driver in the evening before. In the evening or in the night, you have excellent opportunities to make night shots of the amazing African sky. Meals and overnight at the camp Ndololo.

Day 6: Today, you will have an early breakfast and then check out. On the way to the exit you will have your last game drive in Tsavo East Park, for now it goes to Amboseli, which you reach at lunchtime. After lunch at Kibo Camp and a short rest, begins a long game drive. The Amboseli is very small and relatively dry, so you can see the animals very well in or on the marsh. There are the largest elephant herds. With luck, you can have in the evening the chance to see the Kilimanjaro in all its glory as the photo motif in the background and possibly with elephants or giraffes in front. Dinner and overnight at Kibo Camp.

Animals in Amboseli: Elefante, Lion, Leopard, Cheetah, Hippo, Giraffe, Buffalo, Zebra, Eland, Wildebeest, Waterbuck, Thomson Garzelle, Oryx, Impala, ostrich, kudu, Reedbuck, Schabrakenschak and many more ... are Here there are more than 400 species of birds ...

Day 7: Game drives according to wishes of the group ...

Day 8: After an early breakfast you check out and we go to Tsavo West. Directly behind the entrance you pass through the Shetani Lava Flow; Who wants can also climb up short. Now you start a game drive through the breathtaking landscape with lots of animals to Ngulia Lodge. The Tsavo West differs from the very scenic eastern part, because he is very hilly and has more bushland. After lunch and a short break you go to the afternoon game drive and you might see with a little luck a leopard or a rhino, because both are rare. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Animals in Tsavo West: Lion, Leopard, Rhino, Elephant, Buffalo, Giraffe, Zebra, Wild-Dog, Crocodile, Hippo, Impala, Kudu, Dik Dik, Waterbuck, Ostrich, Warthog, etc ... Again, lots of birds ...

Day 9: After an early breakfast is check out and it goes to the Mzima Springs. This place is most beautiful in the morning. On a last game it goes to the output and to Lumo Sanctuary and the Lion Bluff Lodge. This lodge is located on a hill and offers a 360 ° panoramic view. In good weather you can see Kilimanjaro. After a good lunch overlooking the vastness of it we go on an extended game drive until sunset. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 10: After an early morning game drive at sunrise and the following breakfast you will check out. Now it goes to a last game to the exit. Before you start the return journey to your hotel we will take one last lunch at the Lion Hill Lodge. Here you have a fantastic view over the expanse of Tsavo East. In Mombasa you make (if desired) a stop at the Akamba carving village. There you can watch the carvers at work, and acquire these carvings in the adjoining shop. Now it's time to go back to your hotel where you arrive in the late afternoon.

Day 11: Today is much relaxed in the hotel and on the beach. Also, you now have plenty of time to discuss the images of the Safari with Andreas.

Day 12: Another day with Safari, but it is now out to sea. On a trip to the island Wasini you will see if you are lucky dolphins; on the reef you can snorkel. It sometimes happens that dolphins with the snorkelers swim together. After an extensive snorkeling Tour you will have an excelentes Seafood – Lunch on Wasini island. Enjoy the tranquility because after a short break, it goes back to the mainland - Shimoni and to the hotel.

Day 13: Relax and might use again in the round, the opportunity to talk shop ...

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General information about Kenya

Health

The usual precautions apply to Kenya. Drinks should take only from unopened bottles and fruit and vegetables applies - peel it, cook it or forget it. As for Europe, diphtheria, tetanus, polio and hepatitis vaccinations for Kenya, recommended. A yellow fever vaccination is not required for the entry from Europe.

Malaria prophylaxis is recommended for almost all of Kenya. For flu symptoms in the weeks after a trip to Kenya should alert the doctor, to the past trip, so can be tested for malaria.

Medications for pain, diarrhea and fever should be brought.

Clothes

On the beach and in the hotel you can wear normal summer and beach clothes. In Mombasa or in the villages, it is important out of respect for the people, the men do not run with shorts and shirtless, women not with shorts or short skirts and low-cut tops. For the beach and swimming in the sea, should be worn water shoes. On Safari you need for the early morning hours a sweater or fleece jacket and long pants and sturdy shoes, as it can be quite chilly in the morning for the early morning game drive.

Visa

For entry into Kenya, Europeans need a least 6 months after departure, must also have valid passport of another 6 free pages. The tourist visa can be applied for in advance at the Kenyan Embassy in Berlin. However, it can also be easily issued upon arrival directly at the international airport of Mombasa or Nairobi. The fee for the visa is 40 € and it is best to have these in appropriate money. On www.embassy-of-kenya.de you find a Visa - application form.

Money / Credit Cards

The official currency is the Kenya-Schilling and currently the price is 1 Euro = 115 KSH. As a credit card there should be a Visa card that is offered for free by many banks already. EC - Card or Master Card are not working. Money can be exchanged at the bank, exchange offices or at the hotel. Kenya Shillings unfortunately you do not get with a German bank, but one gets directly with a credit card at the airport or exchange Euros directly at the airport. Travellers Cheques are no longer accepted.

Time Difference

During the European summer time it is plus one hour and with winter time there are difference plus 2 hours.

Other

As in Kenya, the power supply is not always given, a flashlight would be very helpful. For charging mobile phone, or other electric devices they need an adapter with 3 poles. The voltage in Kenya is 220/240 V 50 Hz.
